- 6) Motion to approve sending four (4) officers to Pistol Instructor Course at Oakland Police Academy in Auburn Hills, MI, for a cost not to exceed \$2600 Funded through Act 302 Training Funds.
- 7) Motion to approve sending one (1) Fire Department employee to Leadership Conference in Boyne Falls, Michigan from July 8-11, 2019 with a per diem not to exceed \$140 for meals and miscellaneous expenses; as well as the overnight use of a city vehicle
