SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Epidemiologists warn that risk remains high, because while thousands have been infected with COVID-19 — and have built some immunity as a result — the vast majority of the world's population has not. Without a vaccine or widespread immunity, the world remains nearly as vulnerable to a large outbreak as it was at the start of the pandemic.
- State leaders urged those with recently reconnected residential water service to begin the process of working with local water departments to identify assistance programs and financial assistance to remain connected. Nearly, 2,000 homes have been reconnected since late March when Governor Whitmer ordered the restoration of water service under [Executive Order 2020-28](#) to ensure at-risk households have access to clean water for hand washing and other critical sanitation needs.
- The Safe Salons for MI Coalition of barber shops and salon owners representing more than 350 facilities in Michigan have proposed a reopening plan urging Governor Whitmer to lift ban. The plan includes detailed requirements for best practices, customer safety, social distancing, and more.
- With efforts to re-engage Michigan's economy underway through recent executive orders signed by Governor Whitmer, the Pure Michigan Business Connect program through the Michigan Economic Development Corporation has developed a [portal](#) specifically designed to support the personal protective equipment (PPE) needs of Michigan businesses as they start the process of re-opening.
- The French Health Ministry has banned doctors from prescribing hydroxychloroquine to COVID-19 patients after an observational study published in the medical journal The Lancet found that seriously ill COVID-19 patients were more likely to die if treated with hydroxychloroquine and chloroquine.
