Membership Descriptions

(Heritage Skating Academy shall be referred to as "HSA" throughout these descriptions)

Family Membership: Shall consist of one (1) skater: Junior Member under the age of eighteen (18) and one (1) Parent and/or Guardian: over the age of eighteen (18). **Junior Member** shall be entitled to all HSA benefits with the exception of voting rights and the ability to hold an Office or Board of Directors Position. Member will receive a USFS membership. **Parent / Guardian Member** shall be entitled to all HSA benefits including voting rights and is eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors position. Parent / Guardian Member will receive a USFS membership and USFS skating magazine. ****Note:** This membership subject volunteer requirements.

Junior Membership: Shall consist of one (1) skater under the age of eighteen (18). This Membership requires an adjacent Family Membership. Junior Member shall be entitled to all HSA benefits with the exception of voting rights and the ability to hold an Office or Board of Directors Position. Member receives a USFS membership.

Adult Membership: Shall consist of an individual over the age of eighteen (18). Member shall be entitled to all HSA benefits including voting rights and is eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors position. Member receives a USFS membership and USFS skating magazine.

****Note:** This membership subject to volunteer requirements.

Second Club Membership: Eligible persons must be a current USFS "member in good standing" with another USFS club. Member will be entitled to limited club privileges "on and off" the ice. Member shall be allowed to participate in club fundraising opportunities but, does not have voting rights and is not eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors Position. This member does not receive the USFS magazine. Volunteer requirements do not apply to this member.

Professional Membership: These shall be members who are professional ice skating instructors, coaches or judges who are registered as such with USFS to coach or judge at all Skating events. **1st club Professional** is entitled to all club benefits; services and at the discretion of the Board of Directors may or may not be eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors position. Member receives a USFS membership and USFS skating magazine. **2nd club Professional** shall receive limited club benefits and is not eligible to vote or hold an Office or Board of Directors position. Other benefits may apply at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Support Membership: For the individual who is a non-skater that wishes to support their skater(s) and HSA. Member shall be entitled to limited club benefits which does include voting rights and is eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors position. This member does not have any "on" ice privileges. Volunteer requirements do not apply to this member but, member shall be allowed to participate in club fundraising opportunities. Member receives a USFS membership and USFS skating magazine.

High School Membership: This is for the skater wishing to participate **Only** in High School Competitions. If member wishes to compete in other USFS competitions they will be required to upgrade to a Family or Adult Membership. Member is entitled to limited club privileges "on and off" the ice. No voting rights or Board of Directors positions apply. Volunteer requirements do not apply to this member but, member is allowed to participate in club fundraising opportunities. Member receives a USFS membership and skating magazine.

Basic Skills Membership: This Membership is for the USFS Snowplow Sam 1 through Freeskiate 6 level skater(s). Members would represent HSA at USFS Basic Skills Competitions. If a Basic Skills skater wishes to compete in levels higher than Freeskiate 6, they must upgrade to a Family Membership. Member will be entitled to limited club privileges "on and off" the ice. Member does not receive the USFS Skating Magazine. Volunteer requirements do not apply to this member but, member is allowed to participate in "Regular" club fundraising opportunities.

Transfer and Mid-Season Enrollment: Memberships requiring pro-rated: fees; volunteer and fundraising requirements. **Transfer Membership:** Active members of another USFS club, transferring in the middle of a skating season to make HSA their primary USFS club. Note: a "Member in Good Standing" release form is required from the club the member is transferring from. **Mid-Season Enrollment:** Only memberships which are acquired after December 1st, whether they be new or renewal, will be eligible for a pro-rated discount. Above memberships will enter the club under a Family or Adult Membership will be pro-rated for the appropriate fees and obligations. ****Note:** This membership subject to volunteer requirements.

Theatre Membership: This member is not required to have a USFS membership. Membership does not include "on" ice club privileges but, does allow club discounts relating to the TSX Annual Ice Show. This member does not have voting rights and is not eligible to hold an Office or Board of Directors Position. Member does not receive the USFS Skating Magazine. Volunteer requirements do not apply to this member but, member shall be allowed to participate in all club fundraising opportunities.

Fundraising: Raising money to assist HSA in the continued education of your athlete(s) in the sport of figure skating. We are very proud that HSA is one of the few skating clubs that offers Venue Fundraising as one of its many fundraising opportunities. Fundraising proceeds help the club to sponsor a variety of activities for which all members shall have the opportunity to equally participate: Charity events, Club Ice Sessions, Year End Banquets, Summer Parties, Educational Seminars, Holiday Events, Test Sessions, Competitions and more. We hope to not only educate our youth in the sport of figure skating but, allow them to share this experience with others who share some of the same goals and dreams.

Volunteer Support Program: Volunteer requirements apply to: Family; and Adult Memberships including Transfer and Mid-Season Members.

a) Working members: Required ten (10) hours of volunteer hours at club events or fundraisers during a HSA membership year. Volunteer fee is due at time of registration. Fee is fully refundable and will be refunded to member upon completion of volunteer requirement. These volunteer hours shall have no personal financial gain to member.

b) Non-Working members: Required to pay a volunteer fee at time of registration for HSA membership year. If a member should terminate his or her membership before the end of a HSA membership year, no refund of volunteer fee will be given.

Note: Volunteer requirements are designed to secure the financial stability of HSA. Any non-payment or non-fulfillment of obligation may result in becoming a member "NOT" in good standing.
