TSX Winter Extravaganza 2011

- Dates:** December 9th-11th, 2011

- Rules:** The competition will be conducted according to the 2010 ISI Handbook in accordance with all 2012 Rule revisions. It is the coach's responsibility to check the handbook and rule revisions for this competition..
- Deadline:** All entries must be postmarked by **October 24th, 2011**. Entries will be sent to ISI for verification. Skaters must have a current individual ISI Membership Card. Deadline for determining age is **Oct. 24th, 2011**. Deadline for determining age in Synchronized events is July 1st, 2011. ISI Endorsement # **1-1341-2011**
- Fees:** Fees for individual competitors shall be \$50.00 and \$15.00 for each additional event. **This year TSX is offering a special discount to skaters who enter multiple events. The 3rd and 6th individual event will be free of charge.** Synchronized fees shall be \$50.00 per team, plus \$15.00 for each member of the team. Team compulsories, family spotlight, couples, and pairs will be \$15 per skater. Please refer to entry forms for more information. **Late fees (\$10.00 after Oct. 24th and double entry fee after Oct. 31st)** will be charged, due to medals being ordered and ice time allotted for each skater and their events. No refunds unless the division is cancelled or at the discretion of the director.
- Registration:** All competitors should arrive at the rink at least sixty minutes before the scheduled time of their events. The competition may run ahead or behind schedule, depending upon circumstances beyond our control. The registration desk will be open one (1) hour prior to the start of the competition to welcome skaters and receive music tapes. A specific time schedule for all events will be sent to each participating arena prior to the competition.
- Events:** The following areas of competition will be offered. **Pre-Alpha, Alpha, Beta, Gamma, Delta, Freestyle 1-10, Open Freestyle (Bronze- Platinum), Interpretive (FS 3 – 10). Synchronized Teams, Team Compulsory, Compulsory (FS 1-10), Similar & Mixed Couples, Pairs, Footwork, Spotlight (Pre-Alpha – Delta, FS 1- 10), Couples Spotlight(Low-High), & Tot 1-4.**
- Each category will be divided into age groups, with no more than 9 skaters in a group. Age groupings will be based on the following divisions: 4 & under, 5 – 6, 7 – 8, 9 – 10, 11 – 12, 13 – 15, 16 – 20, 21 – 29, 30 – 39, and 40 & over. Age groups will be further divided based on the entries received.
- Females and males are separated in most events, but may be combined in Artistic, Footwork, Interpretive, Solo Compulsories, Spotlight, and Team.
- Eligibility:** All competitors entering this competition must be registered to their highest test level with the ISI as of **October 24th, 2011**. The skating Director, coach and the skater/parent must sign entry forms. Incomplete forms may be returned!
- Judges:** Each participating arena must provide at least one judge for each 10 skaters entered. All judges must be a current ISI Professional member and have passed the ISI Judge Certification tests for the appropriate levels (Bronze – Gold and/or Synchro). All judges who passed any certification test prior to October 1st, 2011 must take the 2012 Update Test to maintain their current certification level.

Coaches: All coaches at any ISI competition must be a current ISI Professional member to put their students on the ice. If these coaches are not certified they can purchase a Coach Credential for \$25. If you are certified and choose not to judge you will be charged a \$25 fee to waive your judging.

Awards: Skaters in all events will be awarded a medal for 1st through 6th place. Overall Team Trophies will be presented to the top three teams.

Music: For all events except Interpretive and Solo Compulsory, the skater must provide music on a **CD ONLY(containing one song only)**. **Please realize not all burned CD's will play in all CD players and TSX is not responsible if a CD will not play in our system.** Please make sure the correct information is clearly marked on each CD. Please be sure you have a back up CD available at rink side. All music must be turned in one hour prior to your event.

Special Event Requirements

Tot 1-4: Each skater will perform a one minute or less routine with the elements from the chosen level. Additional maneuvers from a higher level may not be performed. Although you may include maneuvers from a lower level if you choose but only the elements on the skaters competitive level will be judged.

Tot 1: Proper way to fall
Proper way to get up
Marching in Standing Position
Marching while moving

Tot 3: Push and Glide Stroking
Preparation for Snowplow Stop
Dip
Forward Swizzle

Tot 2: Two-foot jump in place
Forward Swizzles standing still
Single Swizzle
Beginning Two-foot Glide

Tot 4: T position and push (R & L)
Backward Swizzles
Two-foot or One –foot snowplow stop
Backward Wiggles

Compulsories: One minute or less routine without music. Skaters are to perform only the three maneuvers below in any order without music. Each maneuver may only be attempted one time. Additional maneuvers such as any jump, spin, or gliding maneuver from a test level or any uncaptured move are not allowed. Freestyle 1-3 events will be on ½ ice and events from Freestyle 4 and higher will be done full ice.

FS 1: Waltz Jump, Forward Spiral, Forward Pivot

FS 2: Ballet Jump, One – Half Lutz, One Foot Spin

FS 3: Salchow Jump, Dance Step Sequence, Change Foot Spin

FS 4: ½ Loop Jump, Sit Spin, Flip Jump

FS 5: Lutz Jump, Back Spin, Axel Jump

FS 6: Axel/Half loop/ Flip, Spin Combo w/ change of foot and position, Split Falling Leaf

FS 7: Two Walley Jumps, Flying Camel Spin, Double Toe Loop Jump

FS 8: Double Flip Jump, Illusion or Camel jump Camel Spin, Split Lutz Jump

FS 9: Double Lutz Jump, Arabesque/Bauer/Spread Eagle Sequence, Flying Camel/Jump Sit Spin
