

# 2010 Spring Ice Show Registration

The Taylor Sportsplex (TSX) is proud to present its 8<sup>th</sup> annual Spring Ice Show. The show will take place on May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and will feature skaters from the TSX Learn To Skate program along with skaters from the TSX competitive freestyle program and skaters from local arenas. We welcome skaters of all ages and levels to participate in this spectacular event.

## Ice Show Dates and Times

We will have 3 performances. All skaters are required to skate in all 3 performances. The shows will be:

\*\*Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup> @ 7:00pm

\*\* Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00pm and 7:00pm

Groups will practice on Wednesdays between 4p – 8p. (a complete schedule will be posted after Feb 1<sup>st</sup>.) Practices start the 1<sup>st</sup> week of March. A schedule will be available after Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>. The week before the show we will have extra rehearsals with lights and costumes. Please see schedule of events to be posted after the first practice.

## Ice Show Fees and Deadlines

Deadline for Ice Show Registration is **Dec. 21<sup>st</sup>**. Costumes will be ordered the following week to allow time for delivery before pictures. A non-refundable deposit of \$30.00 is required to register for the Ice Show. Your balance will be split into two payments. Payment one will be due by Feb. 1st and payment two (final payment) will be due March 1st. **PLEASE NOTE COSTUMES ARE NOT INCLUDED THIS YEAR. THERE WILL BE A SEPARATE FEE WHICH WILL BE DETERMINED ONCE COSTUMES HAVE BEEN DECIDED. PRICES WILL RANGE FROM \$50-\$70.**

**Package A** - \$75.00 – Includes 1 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches' fees, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Package B** - \$115.00 – Includes 1 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches fees, show sweatshirt, program book & 3 show tickets, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Package C** - \$165.00 - Includes 1 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches fees, show sweatshirt, program book & 5 show tickets, ½ page program ad with pic, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Package D** - \$130.00 – Includes 2 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches' fees, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Package E** - \$170.00 - Includes 2 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches fees, show sweatshirt, program book & 3 show tickets, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Package F** - \$220.00 - Includes 2 group #, 7 weeks practice, coaches fees, show sweatshirt, program book & 5 show tickets, ½ page program ad with pic, this DOES NOT INCLUDE COSTUME FEE. PLEASE SEE COSTUME SECTION FOR DETAILS.

**Solo /Duet /Feature-** \$40.00 - Does not include costume, ice or instructor fees. FEATURE COSTUMES WILL BE ORDERED AND COST WILL BE DETERMINED BY Feb 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **Costumes**

Costume fees and tights are **NOT** included in your registration fee. Costumes will be ordered thru the Heritage Skating Academy. A separate deposit of \$25.00 will be due when you attend on of the below measurement days. The remaining balance will be determined once costume costs are finalized. Prices will range from \$50.00 - \$70.00.

Tights are not included in costume prices. The required type of tights for all skaters will be announced at the first parent meeting to be scheduled in January. Below is a listing of scheduled dates that Staff will be available for measuring skaters for costumes. All costumes must be ordered by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

## **Advertisement and Program Books**

A program book will be created to sell at the Ice Show. It will include pictures of all the groups and solo's involved in the show. You will also have the opportunity to place an ad in the program book featuring a skater or a business. Each skater is responsible to sell at least ½ a page of ads for the Ice Show program book. Also available in the program book are Love Ads. These are 1 and 2 line mini ads to be placed in the back of the book! The revenue from the program books is used to help defray the cost of curtains, lighting, and props. Any skater selling two full pages of ads will receive two complimentary show tickets to the performance of their choice.
